



WORLD DAY FOR SAFETY AND HEALTH AT WORK-28TH APRIL 2019

28th of April in every year is globally recognized as the ‘**WORLD DAY FOR SAFETY AND HEALTH AT WORK**’. In honour of the day, Tanzania also joins other countries across the world to commemorate the day. At national level, the occasion is usually coordinated by the Occupational Safety and Health Authority (OSHA) in collaboration with the Association of Tanzania Employers (ATE), and Trade Union Congress of Tanzania (TUCTA). This year’s commemorations will be held at national level in Mbeya Region under the theme; ***Safety and Health and the future of work towards industrial economy (Usalama na Afya na mustakabali wa kazi kuelekea uchumi wa viwanda)***.

For the purpose of making the commemorations meaningful to stakeholders of safety and health and the general public at large, OSHA has planned to execute a number of activities aiming at raising awareness and promoting safety and health in our country. They activities include;

- i. Safety and Health at work exhibitions for employers to showcase equipment and systems used to protect workers against diseases and accidents at their workplaces.
- ii. Occupational Safety and Health awareness seminars to small and medium scale entrepreneurs in Southern Highlands regions.
- iii. Giving Awards for Occupational Safety and Health (AOSH) to workplace occupiers who are doing commendable job in implementing the OHS Act, 2003.
- iv. Symposium of workplace occupiers on “Vision Zero Campaign” and Industrial Economy. To be held at Usungilo Hotel Conference Hall on 27th April, 2019 from 10:00am.
